Observations of the Committee

The committee after perusal of the related record presented by the IQAC Coordinator makes the following criteria-wise observations:

CURRICULAR ASPECTS

The college is affiliated to Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak and it adheres to the curriculum and academic calendar prescribed by the university. The college follows CBCS for both UG and PG programs. The college is required to focus on the attainment of POs and COs.

TEACHING LEARNING AND EVALUATION

The college organizes induction program for the new students to encourage them to participate in various activities conducted by the college such as related to skill-development, social activities, environmental awareness activities, NSS activities, etc. apart from their own core discipline related activities. Though the college follows mentor-mentee practice but the same need to be a robust mechanism. Many teachers in the college participate in Research in form of books and article publications along with conduct of FDPs. The college needs to encourage more faculty members for the publications, consultancy, and extra mural projects. The college conducts extension activities in the neighborhood community, sensitize students to social issues, for their holistic development and the college inculcates the social awareness among the students.

The college has a good academic infrastructure with good ambiance and lush green campus. The College has few furnished classrooms and Auditorium. The College has a good Library including books, e- journals and e-books. The college has good sports indoor facilities. The college has good IT Infrastructure including 24x7 CCTV monitoring at different places on the campus.

STUDENT SUPPORT AND PROGRESSION

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The college students actively participate in different committees constituted for organizing different activities. The college has a registered Alumni Association that needs to makes more effort in the development of the college through financial and/or other support services.

GOVERNANCE LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT

The college has a visionary management and offers good governance. Teaching staff is involved in different committees and IQAC plays a good role for quality initiatives.

BEST PRACTICES

The college has CCTV cameras across the campus and the college has made provisions for differently abled students.
