ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Emphasizing the role of women Jawaharlal Nehru once said, "Women should be uplifted for the upliftment of the nation, for if a woman is uplifted, society and nation is uplifted".

The 73rd Amendment of Constitution or simply the Panchayati Raj Act, saw over a million women emerge out of their homes to hold public offices at the grassroots level for the first time ever. Getting elected to Panchayat gave them a voice and an opportunity to make a difference. These elected women representatives (EWRs) whether self motivated or encouraged by the Gram Sabha have ended up serving as role models to others. Due to women representatives, nexus of officers and male elected representatives are breaking, which has a direct impact on reducing corruption. Domestic violence has substantially declined due to Women Pradhan or Surpanch. These women representatives pro-actively take up such violence acts. Surely, an endeavor to broad base democracy on this scale is bound to have setbacks and shortcomings, and need course correction. The reservations may bring them into the panchayat but cannot really empower them until barriers such as illiteracy, language, inexperience or low respect commanded among fellow villagers, lack of awareness and male dominance are lifted. Thus, despite increased number of EWRs in the panchayat, women empowerment demands changes in the administrative and social structure through a collaborative, multi pronged approach. Government should encourage research and development in effective implementation of provisions of the 73rd amendment. Providing women with opportunities and support systems has the potential for a change in gendered power relations allowing them to slowly but steadily break the shackles of existing boundaries.

In the seminar we propose to stimulate a proper thinking on the subject. We propose to analyse dispassionately women leadership in Panchayati Raj and also impact of constitutional provision for women in Panchayati administration. This seminar will be a mirror of opinions and views of young scholars and seasoned academicians. The findings of the seminar will be conveyed to our luminaries heading the Education Department at the state and if permitted at Union level.




