This Jeevika Agreement, hereinafter referred to as Agreement, is made on dated 19-09-2024 and is applicable for one year from 20-09-2024 To.19-09-2025

## BY AND BETWEEN

Lotus Petal Charitable Foundation, a charitable trust registered under the Indian Trust Act, 1882 and having its registered office at Khasra No 12/2, Dhunela Berka Road, Village Dhunela, Sohna, Gurgaon, Haryana 122103, hereinafter represented by its authorized representative.(hereinafter referred to "Foundation" which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include its legal heirs, representatives, executors, transferees, successors, attorneys, assignees, and administrators) of One Part; And

K.L. Mehta Dayanand Girls College-Faridabad having it's address at K.L. Mehta Marg, NH-3, NIT-3, Faridabad, Haryana (121001) (hereinafter referred to as the "College", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include his/ her legal heirs, executors, successors, administrators and permitted assignees) of the Other Part.

## TERMS, CONDITIONS AND WARRANTIES OF THE JEEVIKA COURSE PROGRAM

- 1. The college shall allow the Foundation to interact with the students of the College. This interaction shall include giving presentation to the students explaining the courses run by the Foundation, answering questions of the students, signing up the students for the course to be run by the Foundation.
- 2. The College shall allow the Foundation to conduct classes in the College's premises in the working hours of the College. The Foundation shall conduct the classes for two hours on every working day. The exact time slot for the classes shall be decided and planned with mutual agreement and between the College and the Foundation. This time slot can be changed and re-planned with mutual agreement between the College and the Foundation.
- 3. The College shall allow the trainers and other support and back-end staff of the Foundation access of the college premises. The college teachers should ensure the attendance of the students should be more than 80%. The access of the college premises shall only be to conduct the classes, answer queries of the students, meet the admin staff on need to meet basis only. The Foundation staff shall not be allowed to stay in the college beyond the timings of the course classes conducted by the Foundation.

The Foundation, under the terms of this agreement, either commits to installing the systems, workstations and furniture in the suggested room to ensure full operational fair, facilitating utilization by both the college and skill development students. Post the program's completion, the Foundation reserves the right to remove the installed systems, workstations and furniture the college administration shall assume responsibility for safeguarding the assets provided by the Lotus Petal Foundation as per the terms of MOU. A detailed list of the equipment in a separate annexure will be shared and signed post installation work.

- 5. The Foundation shall conduct any of the following courses mentioned in the list below as per NEP 2020 & College preference.
- 6. The courses duration will be 240 Hours. However, any new courses may be added to the list in the future through an amendment to this agreement-

(Sana)

- a. Hardware & Networking
- b. Digital Marketing
- c. Hospitality
- d. Retail & Sales
- e. BFSI (Banking, Financial Services & Insurance)
- 7. Upon successful completion of the course with passing marks, the Foundation will issue a certificate approved by the National Skill Development Council (NSDC). The certificate will prominently feature the logos of both the Foundation and the National Skill Development Council (NSDC).
  - 8. The Foundation guarantees 100% placement assistance upon successful course completion, with the placement process concluding within 60 days. However, placement is contingent on student performance, and candidates are provided three opportunities for interviews.
    - 9. The Foundation shall provide courseware (online/hard copy) during the duration of the course.

The Foundation shall ensure the students are able to obtain a minimum of two industrial visits per batch during the duration of the course.

The Foundation shall provide multiple (maximum 3) opportunity to provide a job placement. Therefore, acceptance or rejection of the job offer by the student shall be the one and only opportunity for the student to participate in the job placement process.

It is further undertaken that Foundation and the College have read, understood and accepted the present Agreement and guarantees to uphold the present Agreement and also acknowledges n event of a breach or damage, suitable action shall be taken.
